

TERMS & CONDITIONS

ACD 8TH RURAL DERMATOLOGY MEETING 2024 and Think Business Events (MEETING Organiser) reserve the right to publish changes to these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.

PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION

The payment of the registration is either by credit card or bank deposit at the time of registration.

After 5 August 2024 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted.

A registration is considered complete when full payment is received by the MEETING Organiser.

Early Bird registration fees
